## THE COUNCIL OF GRADUATE STUDENTS OF MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY ENACTS:

WHEREAS, In service to the Graduate School, the Finance Committee is tasked to evaluate and review the requirements of the award, such as eligible service and superior leadership achievements, or other eligibility criteria within the funding guidelines; and,

RECOGNIZING, The Finance Committee was requested by the Graduate School to update and revise the Disciplinary Leadership Award Funding Guidelines with the creation of the new Diversity, Equity, and Leadership Award; and,

RECOGNIZING, The Finance Committee would like to further ensure that graduate and professional students for the Disciplinary Leadership Award are recognized for their past and current service in professional and disciplinary societies by applying for the correct award; and,

RECOGNIZING, That the Disciplinary Leadership Award is a recognition of service and that how recipients plan to use the award money should not determine their eligibility, and more clarity is needed to ensure applicants apply to the correct award; therefore, be it,

RESOLVED, The COGS Full Council authorizes the revision of Disciplinary Leadership Award Funding Guidelines to 1) completely remove evaluation criteria for how selected recipients will use the award money and 2) provide clarifying language on the differences between the DL and DEI awards; therefore, be it further.

RESOLVED, This resolution will take effect at the end of the Full Council meeting in which it was adopted.
