Uploading Presentations:

All digital 3MT presentation materials (if using any) must be **uploaded by March 7, 2024, 7:00 pm.**

Digital materials uploaded by the deadline will be available on the computer being used in the scheduled adjudication room.

Presenters should also bring a copy of their presentation slides on a USB drive if unforeseen technological difficulties occur preventing access to the submitted presentation.

Timeline: Presenters will be given 3 minutes to present their thesis with use of 1 single static PowerPoint slide (no transitions) and must abide by the national rules included below:

- One single static PowerPoint slide is permitted, but not required. Slide transitions, animations, or 'movement' of any description of the slide content is not allowed.
- No additional electronic media (e.g., sound and video files) are permitted.
- No additional props (e.g., notecards, scripts, pointers, costumes, musical instruments, laboratory equipment) are permitted.
- Presentations are limited to 3:00 minutes maximum and competitors exceeding 3:00 minutes are disqualified.
- Presentations are to be spoken (e.g., no poems, raps, or songs).
- Presentations are considered to have commenced when a presenter begins through movement or speech.
