Title: A Resolution to Appoint the 2025-2026 Director of Equity and Anti-Discrimination

THE COUNCIL OF GRADUATE STUDENTS OF MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY
ENACTS:

WHEREAS, COGS Bylaws section 6.10.1 states that the Director of Equity and Anti-Discrimination shall be “appointed by the Executive Board and approved by the Full Council”; and,

WHEREAS, COGS Bylaws section 6.10.2 states that the Director of Equity and Anti-Discrimination shall “act as liaison to CORES and COPS and other graduate student affinity groups”; and,

WHEREAS, COGS Bylaws section 8.2.1.4.1 states that the Director of Equity and Anti-Discrimination “shall be convened quarterly or more often as needed, whose duty shall be to address issues of equity and inclusion inside COGS while advocating for equity and inclusion across campus”; and,

RECOGNIZING, The Executive Board solicited applications for the Director of Event Planning from the entire graduate/professional student body; therefore, be it,

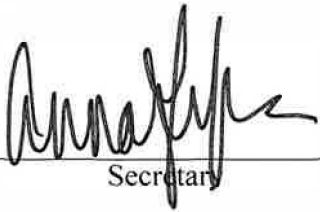
