RE: Student Rights Advocate Annual Report to COGS

As part of the agreement made in 2020 between COGS and ASMSU, it is the role of the Director of the Student Rights Advocates to craft an annual report to submit to COGS. This report will detail the amount of graduate students that the SRA office has worked with in the past academic year along with how many total hours were spent on these corresponding cases.

In the past academic year the SRA office has worked with 9 graduate students totaling 75 hours. Graduate students' cases are far more complex and time consuming than that of undergraduates. Most of these graduate students came from the COM and various other graduate programs, however there were no law students. This agreement has allowed for graduate students to continue to receive our advocacy and due process while also maintaining COGS involvement in the process. We are grateful for both ASMSU and COGS determination in providing assistance to students in need of help throughout the University Judicial System.
